Welcome to THE FIRST ISSUE of the Friends of Grass Lake Township's (FRIENDS) Newsletter!

It is hard to believe it has been **one year** since we first formed. We have made remarkable strides and progress over this period of time.

First and foremost, I would like to thank everyone for their hard work, dedication and support on fundraisers and community events. This small group of neighbors has become a well- established forum for the citizens of Grass Lake Township to have **their voices heard.**

The FRIENDS' accomplishments have been far-reaching with the community and the township. There have been an average of 20 attendees at all Township Board and Planning Commission Meetings and actual progress is taking place. Our input has initiated a more detailed agreement between Target Trucking, the Operators of the Bohne Road Gravel Pit, and the Township that will improve conditions, if they are enforced. Target Trucking and the Township are aware that the 2019 Special Use Permit Renewal will not be a "Rubber Stamped" approval as in the past. To the Township Trustees' surprise, the citizens do care about their quality of life, environment, safety, and are willing to get involved.

As a result of the Norvell Road Mine "Claim of Appeal" case, we have been contacted by other groups in Michigan and now realize this is not just a Grass Lake problem, communities statewide are experiencing similar issues. There are other lawsuits being discussed by private citizens in Grass Lake and nearby townships against other operators of existing pits. We have also been in contact with a group from Saugatuck Township that are just starting a similar legal battle. The FRIENDS' have increased awareness through education of gravel pit issues locally and statewide.

To keep this movement alive, we need help!




What's Happening in Grass Lake Township?

Meet Matt...

An Interview with a Member of the Friends of Grass Lake Twp.

How long have you been in Grass Lake Township?

"My name is Matt Powaga. I have been a Grass Lake Township resident my entire life and my parents lived here before I was born."

Why have you stayed here, Matt? "I love this area, the woods to hunt, the quietness, my family is here and I have never wanted to live anywhere else."

Why did you join the Friends Of Grass Lake Township?

"Things are changing here in Grass Lake and not all of it is good. We expected growth; it's a good place to raise a family. But we never expected to have to deal with things like Gravel Pits in our backyards. The noise and traffic alone will play havoc on our neighborhood. FOGLT are trying to change the way these types of things are allowed to happen by being a big part of Grass Lake Township."

What worries you the most about these changes?

"On my property there runs a small river – a creek if you please. This also runs through the property that has the proposed gravel pit on it. They need somewhere to put the runoff from their extraction and cleaning of the gravel. There is no way to prevent the creek from being polluted. That is one thing, but the thing that worries me the most, is that all these gravel trucks must pass by Warrior Trail, where the kids exit the High School. That is a pure accident waiting to happen. If you love your kids, you wouldn't want them to have to take the chance of pulling out in front of - from north or south, a fully loaded gravel train. They just can't stop! This should be a concern for all of Grass Lake, not just all of us that live on Norvell Road. Friends of Grass Lake Township are working as concerned citizens in an area they love... to try and be a part of what is going on here. That's why I joined..."
